

Regulations for Ordering Videos from Dance Tournaments – DTV

1. General Provisions

1.1. These regulations define the rules for ordering and delivering video recordings during dance tournaments covered by DTV.

1.2. Submitting an order is equivalent to accepting these regulations.

2. Video Delivery

2.1. Each ordering couple receives a high-quality video tailored to the standards of social media publishing. In case of special requirements (e.g., preparation in another format or for purposes other than social media publication), such information must be provided when placing the order.

2.2. Videos are delivered electronically (download link).

2.3. The order fulfillment time is a maximum of 14 business days from the end of the tournament.

3. Recording Rules

3.1. The couple may suggest the round in which the recording should be made.

3.2. The recording schedule is determined based on the order of submissions (priority is given to earlier orders) and the program established by the tournament organizer. In case of conflicting orders, the earlier submission takes precedence.

3.3. If it is not possible to record the suggested round, the video will be made in an adjacent round.

3.4. The number of recordings delivered to the couple may be reduced for reasons beyond the control of DTV, in particular due to:

- changes in the tournament program or schedule,
- changes in competition groups,
- organizational or technical errors,
- mistakes made by the couple (e.g., competing in a different group than registered),
- other unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of DTV.

4. Payments and Invoices

4.1. Payments can be made:

- via bank transfer to the account provided by DTV when the videos are ready for delivery,
- in cash at the tournament venue.

4.2. An invoice can be issued only if such a request is made during the order settlement process.

4.3. The minimum order value is 100 PLN. Once the order has been submitted, cancellation or withdrawal from payment is not possible.

5. Orders

5.1. The order acceptance order is determined by the date of submission.

5.2. Orders may also be placed on the day of the tournament with DTV representatives present at the venue. However, orders submitted before the tournament have priority over those placed during the event.

6. Liability

6.1. DTV makes every effort to ensure that the recordings are delivered in accordance with the expectations of the clients, but is not responsible for situations beyond its control (see point 3.4).

6.2. DTV does not take responsibility for the artistic or competitive quality of the performance of couples, soloists, or formations. DTV's responsibility is limited solely to the professional and reliable execution of the video recording.

6.3. Submitting an order via the application form is equivalent to accepting these regulations.
